REGISTRATION CHECKLIST

The attached application for registration must be fully completed, and all supporting documentation completed and attached in order for it to be processed. Please carefully review the instructions on the back of this page, and use this form as a final checklist to be sure everything is in order before submitting your application.

Registration Application — completed, signed and dated; please mail in a large envelope; do not fold photographs!!! NO FAX COPIES!
Registration Fee — check or money order made payable to JRTCA for full amount of fee (U.S. dollars only!).
JRTCA Membership. If you are not a member, have you enclosed a separate membership application and membership fee (in addition to the registration application & fee)?
Stud Certificate — fully completed and signed by owner of sire.
JRTCA Veterinarian Certificate — completely filled out and signed by veterinarian within 30 days of application. Remember, the original MUST be submitted — no copies!
Photographs - Signed by Veterinarian (3 photos; front and both sides, standing on hard surface with feet visible). No Polaroids! Remember - one photo will be used on your terrier's pedigree.
Pedigree — minimum of 4 generations, signed by breeder. Be sure pedigree includes name and birthdate of terrier, name and address of breeder, and is SIGNED by the breeder.
If submitting trial or natural hunting certificate applications at same time, include \$20 processing fee for each certificate. Only ONE Go-to-Ground certificate is issued per dog; submit Open, Puppy Certificate, or Adult Open qualifying score sheet.

*IMPORTANT NOTE: A Terrier's name, excluding the prefix, is restricted to two words, not to exceed a total of 15 letters/spaces.

Your application WILL NOT BE PROCESSED unless ALL of the above have been submitted correctly!

THE ONLY EXCEPTIONS ARE SPAYED OR NEUTERED TERRIERS; PLEASE USE THE SEPARATE APPLICATION FOR RECORDING!!

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION

Jack Russell Terriers must be over one (1) year of age to apply. Owner must be a current member of the JRTCA. If you are not a current member, you must submit a separate membership application and fee in addition to the registration application and fee. If you do not have a membership application, contact the club office and they will send you one. Each application must include:

Registration/Recording Fee (per dog):

\$25 from JRTCA registered parents (both sire & dam) \$45 from parents (one or both) not registered with the JRTCA \$15 for terriers owned by a Canadian resident and registered with JRTCC

Vet Certificate:

All applications must include a completed JRTCA Veterinarian Form *dated within 30 days of the application;* original only accepted, no photocopies. ALL portions must be completed, and dog's photos must be signed by vet. JRTCC registered terriers do not require a vet certificate.

Pedigree:

One copy of your dog's pedigree showing a minimum of four generations (3 generations acceptable if bred before 1/1/97); must include dog's name and be signed by the breeder. (DO NOT send individual pedigrees of your dog's sire and dam.) The BREEDER of your dog is always the OWNER OF YOUR DOG'S DAM AT THE TIME OF THE MATING! If complete pedigree is not available, a terrier must have at least three generations in order to qualify for recording.

Stud Service Certificate:

Completed and signed by owner of Sire at the time of breeding.

Kennel Name (Prefix)

If the breeder of your dog has a JRTCA registered kennel name, it will be included as a prefix to your dog's name; suffixes (i.e., your kennel name) are not included in the dog's registered name. JRTCA & JRTCC registered prefixes will be used; if the breeder resides in the U.S., the prefix MUST be registered with the JRTCA to be used for registration.

Photos:


Standing photographs of front and both sides of dog in color; write dog's name, date and age (must be at least one year of age at time of photo) on back of each photo. (Dog must be standing on hard surface—feet must be visible. Take photo level with dog. Polaroid photos are not acceptable; all photos become property of JRTCA and will not be returned.) Photos must be signed by veterinarian at time of vet exam.

Registration vs. Recording. Terriers who do not meet the full breed registry requirements, but do meet the general criteria for a Jack Russell, may be recorded. Terriers that possess a genetic defect, possess disqualifying conformational faults, or do not have at least a three-generation pedigree are not eligible for recording unless spayed or neutered. Terriers over or under the height standard are not eligible for registration or recording.

MEASURING YOUR TERRIER

The diagram indicates how and where measurements should be taken. Please make every attempt to measure as accurately as possible; it is an important part of your dog's permanent records.



A. Height Measurement.

Measured from highest point of the shoulder (wither) to the ground; most accurately obtained using a wicket. If a wicket is not available, a straight object (preferable with a level) should be placed across the back, and the measurement taken from that point to the ground using a yard stick or tape measure.

B. Length of Back Measurement.

Measured from the base of the shoulder to the base of the tail; most accurately obtained using tape measure.

C. Chest Measurement.

This measurement is the circumference of the widest point of the chest. Use a tape measure, wrapped completely around dog's body, behind front legs at the widest point of the chest. Pull tape tight to get most accurate measurement.

Terriers over or under the JRTCA height standard are ineligible for registration or recording. 


Registration Photographs

Three (3) photographs, taken in color, of the terrier standing on a level hard surface with the feet visible. The photographs are to be taken from the front, left and right sides. The photographs should portray the terrier in a natural position. Outdoor shots are preferable with good contrast between the terrier and the background. On back of the photograph write the terrier's full name, date of photograph and terrier's age. Photographs must be signed by the veterinarian during the completion of the Veterinary Certificate for Registration.

General Points: Fill the frame, i.e. get the terrier as large as possible in the picture, we may be unable to assess the conformation of a tiny dog in a big picture. Take pictures are the terrier's level, rather than from above or downward angle. Photographs taken from above are deceiving as they portray a longer back and shorter leg. Do not photograph the terrier standing in the grass as the feet are not visible. All four feet must be on the same level surface.




Front View: Taken directly from the front of terrier, standing square. Ensure both head and feet are in picture. Ears should be in a natural, relaxed position.



Right Side: Taken square on to the right side (not from an angle). Head, front and back feet visible. Terrier should be standing square.

REMEMBER:

- Photographs must be signed by the Veterinarian.
- Do not cut photographs.



Left Side: Taken square on to the left side (not from an angle). Head, front and back feet visible. Terrier should be standing square.
