As a service to breeders, and to insure correct registration records, the JRTCA maintains a registry of kennel names. **Only JRTCA registered kennel names may be used as a prefix when registering a terrier in the JRTCA Registry.**

This is a permanent registration, and assures that the kennel name will be registered only once, in your name only. It also ensures that your kennel prefix will be a permanent part of the name of any terrier bred by you.

There are more than 2,300 kennel names currently registered; **please note that names which are the same or very similar to a name already registered will not be accepted.**

The fee for kennel name registration is \$200. Please carefully review the detail regarding registered kennel names on the reverse side of this application.

Kennel names should be brief and concise; remember, it will be used a PREFIX to a dog's registered name. Names may not include words such as Farm, Kennel, The, Terrier, Jack Russells, etc. Kennel names may contain no more than two words, and may not exceed 18 letters/spaces.

Terms/conditions of JRTCA Kennel (Prefix) Registration:

- (1) The fee for registering a kennel name is \$200.00.
- (2) A signed JRTCA Breeders Code of Ethics (BCOE) must be submitted with the application. As a JRTCA member/breeder, you are expected to adhere to this BCOE.
- (3) The owner(s) of said prefix must be current members of the JRTCA in good standing at the time of application, and must be at least 18 years of age.
- (4) The kennel name shall be permanently registered, regardless of whether the owner(s) remain a member of the JRTCA.
- (5) The registered kennel name will become a permanent prefix to any Jack Russell Terrier bred by the owner(s) of the kennel name.
- (6) The dam of the offspring who will carry such prefix **MUST** be registered to ALL owners of any registered kennel prefix. *(i.e., if the kennel prefix is registered to MARY & JOHN SMITH, the terrier producing the offspring to carry the prefix must also be registered to BOTH Mary & John Smith.)*
- (7) Any co-owned terriers whose offspring are to carry this registered prefix must be registered to both owners, and include a signed and dated contract clearly indicating the prefix that is to be used.
- (8) An annual update may be required in order to keep this kennel name on an "active" list. This active list will include only those kennels that are current members of the JRTCA in good standing, who complete an annual kennel activation form. A small annual administrative fee will be applicable.
- (9) A kennel name may be revoked by the JRTCA Board of Directors in the event of a serious breach of the JRTCA Breeders Code of Ethics that has been substantiated by the JRTCA.
