### **Important Notes**

- NO POST ENTRIES. ONLINE DEADLINE 9/13/24; if mailed, entry MUST be postmarked by 9/09/24. THE MAILING DEADLINE WILL BE STRICTLY ADHERED TO AFTER THIS DATE YOU WILL NEED TO ENTER ONLINE. Please carefully review entry form before mailing, and confirmation when received. There will be NO changes, additions, or substitutions allowed after the deadline. The only exceptions will be if a terrier has been entered under the wrong coat or height division, or for the working classes as noted below.
- ADULT ENTRIES IN ALL SANCTIONED DIVISIONS MUST BE JRTCA REGISTERED OR RECORDED TO A CURRENT JRTCA MEMBER. Registration applications requiring processing prior to Nationals MUST be postmarked no later than 9/02/24. Applications for pups reaching the age of one year between 9/02/24 and 10/11/24 must also be submitted by 9/02/24; the application will be pre-approved, and registration certificate issued when terrier reaches one year of age.
- Terriers pre-entered in the Conformation Division that have earned a Natural Hunting Certificate or a Bronze Medallion between 9/11/24 and 10/11/24 only may post enter the Working Terrier or Bronze Medallion classes by submitting proof of certification to trial secretary prior to 11:00 am on Saturday, 10/12/24.
- TERRIERS MAY NOT ENTER BOTH THE OPEN & WORKING SECTIONS or cross enter within the open or working sections of the Conformation Division. Puppies who have previously competed in Puppy CH GTG or Super Earth are not permitted to enter the OPEN Puppy in those divisions.
- NEW PRONG collars are prohibited in the conformation ring.
- All National Trial exhibitors and owners MUST be current members of the JRTCA.
- Note: Agility judge will give briefing and walk-through to EXHIBITORS ONLY prior to each class. There will be NO practice runs.
- Puppies are eligible to compete only if they have reached their four-month birthday; i.e., four months to the date of their birth, NOT 16 weeks.
- **Refunds for classes** will be given only in cases of accident or illness to a terrier or owner, or for bitches in heat; situations must be documented in writing. <u>Approved refunds will be provided by mail within 30 days following the trial, or by credit memo at the trial which may be used for the National raffle or post entries only.</u>
- No dogs other than working terriers will be permitted near any of the event areas.
- Please travel with health records of your terriers, especially rabies certificates.
- Pups under the age of 3 mos, and bitches in season, are not permitted on the trial grounds. Anyone violating trial rules will be excused from all classes and asked to leave the trial site; no refunds will be given. In addition, violations will be documented and violators may be subject to additional penalties. This includes camping area.
- Anyone wishing to sell items at the National Trial must register as a vendor; contact the club office at 410-561-3655 for a vendor application or further information. Absolutely no merchandise of any type may be sold at the trial, either from the vendor area or exhibitor area, unless registered as a vendor.
- Breakfast, lunch, and refreshments will be available throughout the trial.
- No displaying of puppies for sale on site, including advertising signage of puppies for sale.


NO PUPPIES UNDER 3 MOS OF AGE.



#### General Rules for Exhibitors (See JRTCA Rule Book for rules of each division)

- 1. All sanctioned classes are open to Jack Russell Terriers only.
- 2. Exhibitors and owners of terriers entered must be current JRTCA members and not be a member of a conflicting JRT organization or register their JRTs in any all-breed registry or conflicting JRT organization. If an exhibitor is found to be in violation of this policy, entry will be disqualified, and no refunds will be given. If a violation is confirmed after the trial, placements will be voided from all JRTCA records. Exhibitors must submit a completed entry form including a signed waiver for every trial they enter.
- 3. Entries MUST be within the 10-15" JRTCA height standard for all sanctioned classes (with the exception of pups who have not yet met the 10" height standard); measuring devices will be available on the trial grounds.
- 4. Puppies (under 12 months) are not eligible for championship in any division but their own. Puppies are eligible to compete only if they have reached their four-month birthday (not 16 weeks). A puppy's age is the actual age the pup is on the day of the trial.
- 5. Bitches in season may not compete in any division. Pre-entry fees of bitches in season will be refunded with a veterinarian certificate, or as otherwise agreed upon by the Trial Chairperson.
- 6. Spayed or neutered terriers may compete in Miscellaneous Conformation. They may not compete in Puppy, Family\*, Open or Working Conformation. \*Note: For Family Classes, Brood Bitches and Stud Dogs entered may not be spayed/neutered. The offspring at their sides may be intact or spayed/neutered.
- 7. A terrier bred by a sanctioned JRTCA Judge may not be shown under that Judge in the conformation division.
- 8. Terriers owned or co-owned by the Trial Chairperson, or any member of their household, may not be entered in any phase of the competition, with the exception of Child and Youth Handling.
- 9. Terriers owned by judges may not be entered in the division or section in which they are judging but may enter the competition in any other division. (Exception Ring 2 Nationals judge may have terriers shown in Ring 1)
- 10. Terriers owned by stewards may be entered in any division provided that they find a substitute to perform their duties or have someone else show their terriers.
- 11. Requests for the measurement of a terrier entered in any class number may be made only by another exhibitor in that same class number or by the Judge EXCEPT in Racing. Requests for the measurement of a terrier in Racing may be made by the Judge or by an exhibitor with a terrier entered in the same class number; OR, if classes are split by gender, may call for the measurement of a terrier of the opposite gender in the same age and height category. (Example: The owner of an under adult dog entered in Racing may call for the measurement of an under adult bitch as the potential exists for them to race each other in the Championship Races.) Exhibitors racing puppies may call for the measurement of a puppy in a different age category as long as it is in the same height category. The person making the request for measurement must name the terrier or terriers they wish to have measured, but requests for measurement of entire classes will not be honored. The measurement of the terrier will be considered the terrier's official height for the duration of the trial. Only JRTCA height cards issued after September 1999 will be honored.
- 12. Excessive use of squeaky or fur-like baiting devices by exhibitors is prohibited in the Conformation ring and may result in the exhibitor being excused from the class. "Excessive use" will be at Judge's discretion.
- 13. Exhibitors participating in the JRTCA Working Terrier classes, or Certificate Go-To-Ground and Super Earth must submit the appropriate JRTCA certificates with pre-entries or at the time of post-entry. The Judge may require a copy of the certificate be presented to the Ring/Den steward at time of judging. Registered terriers may submit a copy of NHC application signed by a JRTCA Working Judge within 30 days of the date it was issued.
- 14. Puppies under the age of three months are not permitted on the trial grounds. Any person violating this rule will be excused from all classes entered and asked to leave the trial site. (This applies to RV's and Campers, if at the same address as the trial grounds).
- 15. All dogs must be leashed or crated except when competition requires off-leash work. No liberty leashes allowed.

#### General Rules for Exhibitors - Continued

- 16. Overly aggressive dogs, or an owner's failure to control their dog, may result in disqualification at the discretion of the Judges or the National Trial Committee.
- 17. The abuse or severe disciplining of dogs on the trial grounds is prohibited. Anyone displaying such behavior will be asked to leave the trial site, and no entry fees will be refunded.
- 18. Dogs other than JRTs on the grounds may be excluded or permitted at the discretion of the Trial Chairperson.
- 19. Exhibitors are responsible to double check the classes they have entered and be on time. No refunds will be given for missed classes.
- 20. The owner/handler of a terrier entering any class does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by the rules of the JRTCA and the trial. A copy of the JRTCA Rule Book can be downloaded from the JRTCA website (therealjackrussell.com).
- 21. Unsportsmanlike conduct, or the use of foul and abusive language, will not be tolerated. Anyone demonstrating such conduct will be asked to leave the trial site and no entry fees will be refunded. In addition, such conduct will be subject to penalties which may include the suspension of membership, restriction from entering the JRTCA National Trial, and/or fines. Trial Chairpersons have the right to refuse any entry at their discretion.
- 22. All dogs brought to the trial must be current on vaccinations. No dogs of any age may be brought to a trial who have suspicion of contagious or infectious disease. Proof of vaccinations should be made available upon request.
- 23. Judges may not eat, smoke, vape or use cell phones while judging their events.
- 24. THE JUDGE'S DECISIONS ARE FINAL IN ALL DIVISIONS.

ALL TERRIERS MUST BE MUZZLED FOR JRTCA RACING!

Plastic basket muzzles or close-ended cloth muzzles only. No figure eight,

open-ended, or Baskerville muzzles will be allowed.

COLORED MUZZLES ARE NOT ALLOWED. Black, brown, clear or white muzzles are acceptable.

# **DIVISION A: RACING** (Starting promptly at 9:00 AM. Veterans/Seniors may NOT cross-enter into any other racing classes.) Section 1. Flat Races

### Class 1: Pups, 6 up to 9 months, up to $12\frac{1}{2}$ "

- Class 2: Pups, 6 up to 9 months, over 12½ up to 15"
- Class 3: Pups, 9 up to 12 months, up to  $12\frac{1}{2}$ "
- Class 4: Pups, 9 up to 12 months, over 12½ up to 15"
- Class 5: Senior Dogs, 9 years and older, 10 up to 121/2"
- Class 6: Senior Dogs, 9 years and older, over 121/2" up to 15"
- Class 7: Senior Bitches, 9 years and older, 10 up to 121/2"
- Class 8: Senior Bitches, 9 years and older, over 12½" up to 15"
- Class 9: Dogs, 1 year and older, 10 up to 12½"
- Class 10: Dogs, 1 year and older, over 12½ up to 15"
- Class 11: Bitches, 1 year and older, 10 up to 121/2"
- Class 12: Bitches, 1 year and older, over 12½ up to 15"
- Class 13: Veteran Dogs, 6 years and older, 10 up to 121/2"
- Class 14: Veteran Dogs, 6 years and older, over 12½ up to 15"
- Class 15: Veteran Bitches, 6 years and older, 10 up to 121/2"
- Class 16: Veteran Bitches, 6 years and older, over 12½ up to 15"

#### NOTE:

- (1) A terrier must FINISH BOTH a flat and a hurdle race as defined in the posted rules.
- (2) Terrier must place first in the final race for that class. First place may be in flats and/or hurdles.
- (3) Terrier who has not entered or FINISHED a race in both flats and hurdles is not eligible for champion-ship run off and the second place terrier qualifies for championship run off if the terrier meets the criteria listed above.

A Finished Race is when a terrier has run down the race track unassisted by anyone and goes through the barrier with a secured muzzle.

### Section 2. Steeplechase Races (over low hurdles - up to 8")

- Class 17: Pups, 6 up to 9 months, up to  $12\frac{1}{2}$ "
- Class 18: Pups, 6 up to 9 months, over 12½ up to 15"
- Class 19: Pups, 9 up to 12 months, up to  $12\frac{1}{2}$ "
- Class 20: Pups, 9 up to 12 months, over  $12\frac{1}{2}$  up to 15"
- Class 21: Senior Dogs, 9 years and older, 10 up to 12½"
- Class 22: Senior Dogs, 9 years and older, over 121/2" up to 15"
- Class 23: Senior Bitches, 9 years and older, 10 up to 12½"
- Class 24: Senior Bitches, 9 years and older, over 121/2" up to 15"
- Class 25: **Up to 12**1/2" **Puppy Champion & Reserve.** Open to 1st place winners of classes 1, 3, 17 & 19. No entry fee.
- Class 26: Over 12½ up to 15" Puppy Champion & Reserve. Open to 1st place winners of classes 2, 4, 18 & 20. No entry fee.
- Class 27: **10 up to 12**½" **Senior Racing Champion & Reserve.** Open to 1st place winners of classes 5, 7, 21 & 23. No entry fee.
- Class 28: Over 12½ up to 15" Senior Racing Champion & Reserve. Open to 1st place winners of classes 6, 8, 22 & 24. No entry fee.

#### (Over higher hurdles - over 8")

- Class 29: Dogs, 1 year and older, 10 up to 12½"
- Class 30: Dogs, 1 year and older, over 12½ up to 15"
- Class 31: Bitches, 1 year and older, 10 up to 121/2"
- Class 32: Bitches, 1 year and older, over 12½ up to 15"
- Class 33: Veteran Dogs, 6 years and older, 10 up to 121/2"
- Class 34: Veteran Dogs, 6 years and older, over 12½ up to 15"
- Class 35: Veteran Bitches, 6 years and older, 10 up to 121/2"
- Class 36: Veteran Bitches, 6 years and older, over 12½ up to 15"
- Class 37: 10 up to 121/2" Adult Champion & Reserve. Open to 1st place winners of classes 9, 11, 29 & 31. No entry fee.
- Class 38: Over 12½ up to 15" Adult Champion & Reserve. Open to 1st place winners of classes 10, 12, 30 & 32. No entry fee.
- Class 39: **10 up to 12**1/2" **Veteran Champion & Reserve.** Open to 1st place winners of classes 13, 15, 33 & 35. No entry fee.
- Class 40: Over 12½ up to 15" Veteran Champion & Reserve. Open to 1st place winners of classes 14,16, 34 & 36. No entry fee.

Any calls for racing measurements MUST be made by 8:00 AM. Measurements will be done at the entry tent by sanctioned conformation judges not participating in racing.

### DIVISION B: OBEDIENCE (Starting promptly at 8:30 AM)

- Class 41: **Open**. To be judged individually; heel free, figure 8, drop on recall, retrieve on flat, retrieve over high jump, broad jump. Go out.
- Class 42: **Novice.** To be judged individually: heel on leash, off leash figure 8, stand for exam, recall over jump. Honor sit or down.
- Class 43: **Sub-Novice A.** Open to terriers that do not hold a Sub Novice or Novice title. All commands on leash. To be judged individually: heel, heel figure 8, stand for exam, recall. Honor sit or down.
- Class 44: **Sub-Novice B**. Open to terriers that hold a Sub Novice or Novice title All commands on leash. To be judged individually: heel, heel figure 8, stand for exam, recall. Honor sit or down.
- Class 45: **Brace**: Two dogs performing sub-novice exercise together judged on sub-novice criteria. Dogs may be on two leashes or coupled. Braces to be judged on precision. (The brace that works as one stands the best chance of winning; one score sheet for two terriers.)

NOTE: The dogs with the two highest combined scores from classes 41, 42 and 44 will be Obedience Trial Champion and Reserve.

# DIVISION O - NOSE WORK (Starting at 1 pm in Obedience Building) - See classes and description at the end of the class list starting with class #207.

Classes to be held Saturday, October 12th:

### DIVISION C. RALLY-O (Starting promptly at 8:30 AM)

A course consisting of numbered stations with an exercise at each station performed over a timed course. Judged on fastest time with least amount of faults.

- Class 46: Senior Rally-O. Same course as Rally I. Open to terriers nine years and older. May cross-enter into Rally I but only Senior score will count toward High Score and Reserve.
- Class 47: Rally I Novice. Open to terriers that do not have a Rally 1 title in any rally venue. Performed on-lead at normal walking pace. Must have some knowledge of Obedience. (Not included in high score)
- Class 48: Rally I. Open to terriers that hold a Rally 1 title. Performed on-lead at a normal walking pace. Must have some knowledge of Obedience. May not cross-enter into Class 47.
- Class 49: Rally II. More advanced course performed off-lead.

NOTE: HIGH SCORE & RESERVE AWARDED TO THE HIGHEST COMBINED SCORES IN CLASSES 46, 48 & 49.

### DIVISION D: CONFORMATION (Ring #1, starting promptly at 9:30 AM)

Section 1 4–6 Month Pups. (To be held in Ring #1) Judged on JRTCA Breed Standard.

- Class 50: Dog Pups, 4 up to 6 months
- Class 51: Bitch Pups, 4 up to 6 months
- Class 52: Best 4–6 Month Puppy & Reserve. Open to 1st & 2nd place winners of classes 50 and 51.
- Section 2. 6-12 Month Puppy Conformation
- Class 53: Dog Pups, 6 up to 9 months
- Class 54: Dog Pups, 9 up to 12 months
- Class 55: Best Puppy Dog & Reserve. Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of classes 53 and 54.
- Class 56: Bitch Pups, 6 up to 9 months

Conformation will be held under a large pavillion. A limited number of parking spaces are available along the conformation rings. They are offered at \$25 for the weekend to anyone who has five or more terriers entered in conformation, on a first-come, first-serve basis. ### DIVISION F: GO-TO-GROUND (Starting promptly at 9:00 AM - Pre-Novice and Novice will close at 2 PM)

- Class 101: **Open Puppy.** Open to Jack Russells 6 up to 12 months which have scored 100% in a Novice G-T-G class at this or a previous JRTCA trial; not open to any puppy who has previously competed in Puppy CH GTG. **Puppies earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Puppy Championship class at this trial.** (1 second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter; work quarry for one minute.)
- Class 102: **Open Adult.** Open to adult Jack Russell which has scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. May not enter the Championship Certificate class at this trial. (1 second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter; work quarry for one minute.)
- Class 103: **Puppy Championship.** Open to Jack Russells 6 up to 12 months which have earned 100% in an Open G-T-G class at this trial or a previous JRTCA trial. A copy of a 100% open score sheet must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to Den Steward at time of the class. First and second place winners to be Puppy G-T-G Champion and Reserve. (1 second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter; work quarry for one minute.)
- Class 104: **10 up to 12½" Championship Certificate.** Open to Jack Russells one year or older who hold a JRTCA Trial Certificate. First and second place winners to be G-T-G Champion and Reserve. (1 second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one minute.)
- Class 105: **Over 12**½ **up to 15**″ **Championship Certificate.** Open to Jack Russells one year or older who hold a JRTCA Trial Certificate. - Class 106: **10 up to 12**½" **Veteran Championship Certificate.** Open to adult JRs 6 years and over which hold a JRTCA Trial Certificate. First and second place winners to be Veteran G-T-G Champion and Reserve. *May not cross enter into any other class*.

- 5. Handler must stay behind the starting line for the first 30 seconds. After the initial 30 seconds, handler may approach the tunnel and coach the dog to completion.



High Score & Reserve will be awarded to the fastest time each day.

### DIVISION M: Ball Toss (Non-Sanctioned; Sat -1 PM to 3:00 PM) Run by Kay Sadowsky.

Ball toss is a timed event. Three (3) tosses with best time recorded. Ball is tossed a specific distance; dog must retrieve the ball back over the start/finish line with each toss/retrieval timed. A variety of balls will be provided, or you may use your dog's "favorite" ball. Placement ribbons 1st-6th for each class, Best Overall Time and Reserve will be awarded. \$14.00 entry fee.

### How Fast Can Your Jack Russell Find the Quarry?

(Non-Sanctioned; Sunday 9:30 to 11:30 AM) Pre or Post Entry - \$20

Winner gets 40%, reserve gets 20% - No ribbons/trophies.

Class 202: **Stakes Tunnel Race.** Open to any Jack Russell Terrier over one year of age. Tunnel approximately 30-40 feet in length, no blinds or dead ends. Terriers encouraged to work quarry at end of tunnel but not mandatory. Fastest time to the quarry wins.

### DIVISION O: NOSE WORK (Scenting). To be held at 1 PM on Friday in the Obedience Building.

Scent detection is a sport for dogs any age and can even be done by blind, deaf and disabled dogs. Open to dogs at least six months of age. All searches require passing through a start line and calling alert when a hide is found. Locations of the hides are unknown to handlers. Time faults are issued for dropped food, failure to enter through start line and excessive disturbance of search areas. Teams are disqualified for fouling the search area and going over allowed time. More information can be found in the JRTCA TNT Nosework Rule Book.


Class 207: **Level 1 Containers.** 8 to 10 identical containers with one birch hide and a two-minute time limit. One incorrect call allowed but incurs a 5-second fault. Placements for fastest time with no faults first.

Class 208: **Level 1 Interior.** One birch hide, no higher than 12" on any object in a search area approximately 10 x 20 feet. One incorrect call allowed but incurs a 5-second fault. Time allowed is judge's decision. Can be up to Placement is fastest time without faults. Can be done off lead at judge's discretion.

Class 209: Level 2 Containers. 10 to 12 containers can be different. Can also be elevated. There are 2 hides, can be birch, anise or clove. "Alert" is called when hide is found. Must call "finish" to stop the clock when both hides are found. Maximum time will be given if finish is not called. Time allowed is 2:00 minutes. Incorrect call stops the search and results in NQ.

Class 210: **Level 2 Exterior.** A clearly marked search area will cover approximately 20 x 40 square feet.. Hides can be as high as two feet. Hides will not be buried in the ground. There will be two hides made of birch, anise or clove. The handler calls "alert" when a hide is found and "finish "to stop the clock when both hides are found. Judge decides time allowed. Can be up to 4:00 minutes. Can be done on or off lead at judge's discretion. An incorrect call stops the search and results in NQ.

High Score & Reserve will be awarded to the fastest combined times in Level 1 (classes 207 & 208) and in Level 2 (classes 209 & 210).

### YOUTH DIVISION

Youth High Score and Reserve will be awarded to the highest scoring youth, aged 10-16 years, competing with the SAME adult terrier. The quality and achievements of the terrier are not to be considered. Judged on the youth's knowledge and ability to handle the terrier. Points to be awarded as follows: 1st = 8 points, 2nd = 6 points, 3rd = 5 points, 4th = 4 points, 5th = 3 points, 6th = 2 points, and participation = 1 point. To be eligible for the High Score and Reserve, you must compete in a minimum of three and up to four classes. A tie will be broken in Ring 2. Awards to be presented Saturday afternoon.

All Youth Handler classes are for those children aged 10-16 years. **YOUTH HANDLERS MAY ONLY COMPETE WITH THE SAME** | **ADULT TERRIER.** A Child Handler class is being offered for those children aged 5-9 years.

A Youth Division Meeting will be held at 8:30 AM on Saturday in the main building. (See Agenda) All child and youth handlers, as well as their parents, are encouraged to attend. Score sheets will be included in your entry packet.

Youth Division classes will be held on Saturday only; see the agenda and class list for times. Youth classes will be held as scheduled, and all exhibitors will report, with their terriers, as a group for each class. A Sportsmanship Award will be presented to the Child Handler and to the Youth Handler who demonstrate exceptional sportsmanship throughout the weekend. As a reminder the following are the age requirements for the Youth Division:

Child Handler (ages 5 through 9) and Youth Handler (ages 10 thru 16): a child/youth exhibitor's age is determined as of January 1st of the calendar year. Specifically, a child/youth handler participates at the age he/she is on January 1st of the calendar year.

All Youth exhibitors must be current members of the JRTCA. For further information concerning the Youth Division, please contact the Youth Subcommittee Co-Chairmen.
